

- **Imagine you are given a spaceship. Where will you fly it?**
- **Write a postcard to an alien who lives on Mars. You might want to ask them questions like: What do you eat? Who are your family?**
- **Draw a picture of an imaginary planet. What colour is it? Does it have water on it? Are there rivers of chocolate?**
- **Write a description of your planet. Use adjectives (describing words) to describe your planet.**
