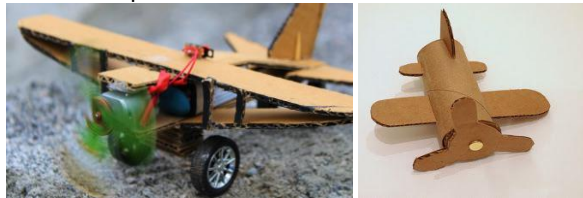
Can you predict what the largest and smallest totals would be with 4 or 5 dice?
