You use equivalent fractions to make them the same. A common multiple of 2 and 3 is 6. So, for each fraction we need an equivalent fraction with a denominator of 6. Now you can add these together:</p> $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{3} = ?$ $\frac{1 \times 3}{2 \times 3} = \frac{3}{6} \quad \frac{1 \times 2}{3 \times 2} = \frac{2}{6}$ $\frac{3}{6} + \frac{2}{6} = \frac{5}{6}$ </div> <p>Look on Google Classroom for worksheet to fill in.
