Sports Day – Wednesday 23rd June

I'm excited to announce the details of our 2021 Colvestone Sports Day!

Team Kickstart will be involved in our sports day this year which has resulted in some new activities being introduced such as welly throwing (!) and javelin as well as old favourites such as the sack race and egg and spoon race. Sprint races will take place after these activities. There may even be an adult race....

Children will compete as part of their 'house team'. For newer parents, every child in the school is assigned to a house team – red, yellow, black, blue and green. This means each team will be a mix of pupils from Nursery to Year 6. Siblings are placed in the same house team. Aside from competing with other teams, children will earn points for team work.

Your child will be given a school headband with their team colour so there is no need for them to wear a team colour t-shirt. **They will need to come to school on Wednesday dressed in their Colvestone PE uniform just as they do for 'sport Fridays'**. A reminder is below:

Our sports day will take place on **Hackney Downs from approximately 10am until 2pm**. Your child will need a healthy packed lunch. No sweets, chocolate or fizzy drinks please. If your child is entitled to free school meals, they will automatically receive a school packed lunch. If you do not require a school lunch, please could you inform the office.

Please ensure your child is protected from the sun (even if it is cloudy) as we will be outside for most of the day – whether this is a hat/cap and/or sunscreen. The current weather forecast is a mixture of rain and sun. Obviously this may change and we will make a decision about the viability of holding sports day outside on the day itself.

Sadly, as you are aware, parents/carers are not permitted to attend due to COVID restrictions.
