You will be aware that our Year 6 pupils undertook their end of key stage statutory assessments this May. This is the first time in 2 years that pupils have taken their SATs and after interrupted learning due to the pandemic they took everything in their stride in order to prepare for their tests this year.

As you know, SATs outcomes are just a part of the children's experience at Colvestone and the emphasis on the education of the whole child is key to our success.

Our outcomes this year surpassed those of 2019 and we are so proud of the Year 6 pupils this year. Against a backdrop of reading, writing and maths combined score dropping nationally, Colvestone has exceeded not only our own set targets but national and Hackney outcomes. Please see table below:

Our Year 6 pupils are well placed for the next steps of their educational journey and can go into Year 7 with confidence. Our outcomes in spelling, punctuation and grammar were the highest we've had as a school at 75% and of the pupils in receipt of pupil premium funding (PPG) 89% achieved the expected standard or higher.

100% of pupils who started their learning journey in Nursery or Reception at Colvestone and are finishing with us in two weeks achieved the expected standard.

I am not sure words can express how immensely proud we are of the children and their parents for the continued support and belief in the Colvestone values and ethos.
